This week, just 138 more people received regular UI benefits than last week, bringing the weekly total to 8,462. Compared to last year, 1,191 fewer people obtained regular UI compensation, which is 12.3 percent less than the fifty-second week of 2014.


The number of weeks compensated does not equate to the number of people receiving benefits. This is because it is possible for an individual to receive multiple weeks of compensation under certain circumstances. The total number of people who have received benefits this week for all regular programs, including UI, UCFE and UCX claimants, is 8,064.


This week, \$43,169 more was expended for regular UI activity than last week, bringing the total to \$2.48 million. Compared to the fifty-second week of 2014 \$234,770 less was spent for regular UI compensation, an 8.7 percent decrease. The average weekly benefit payment for regular UI this week was \$292.54. An increase of \$0.34 from last week.


## Weeks Compensated for Week Ending 12/26/2015 Regular Only

## Total Benefits Paid


Fifty-Second Week of Each Year 2003- 2015
