

February 2024




Idaho and National Labor Force Compared



In February 2024, Idaho's Total Nonfarm Added 4000 Jobs, Growing by 0.5%



Statewide Seasonally Adjusted Change by Industry




Over-the-month Change in Nonfarm Payroll Jobs by Industry, February 2024

Over-the-year Change in Nonfarm Payroll Jobs by Industry, February 2024





Idaho Nonfarm Jobs (CES): Statewide Seasonally Adjusted Change by MSA




Over-the-month Change in Total Nonfarm Payroll, February 2024


