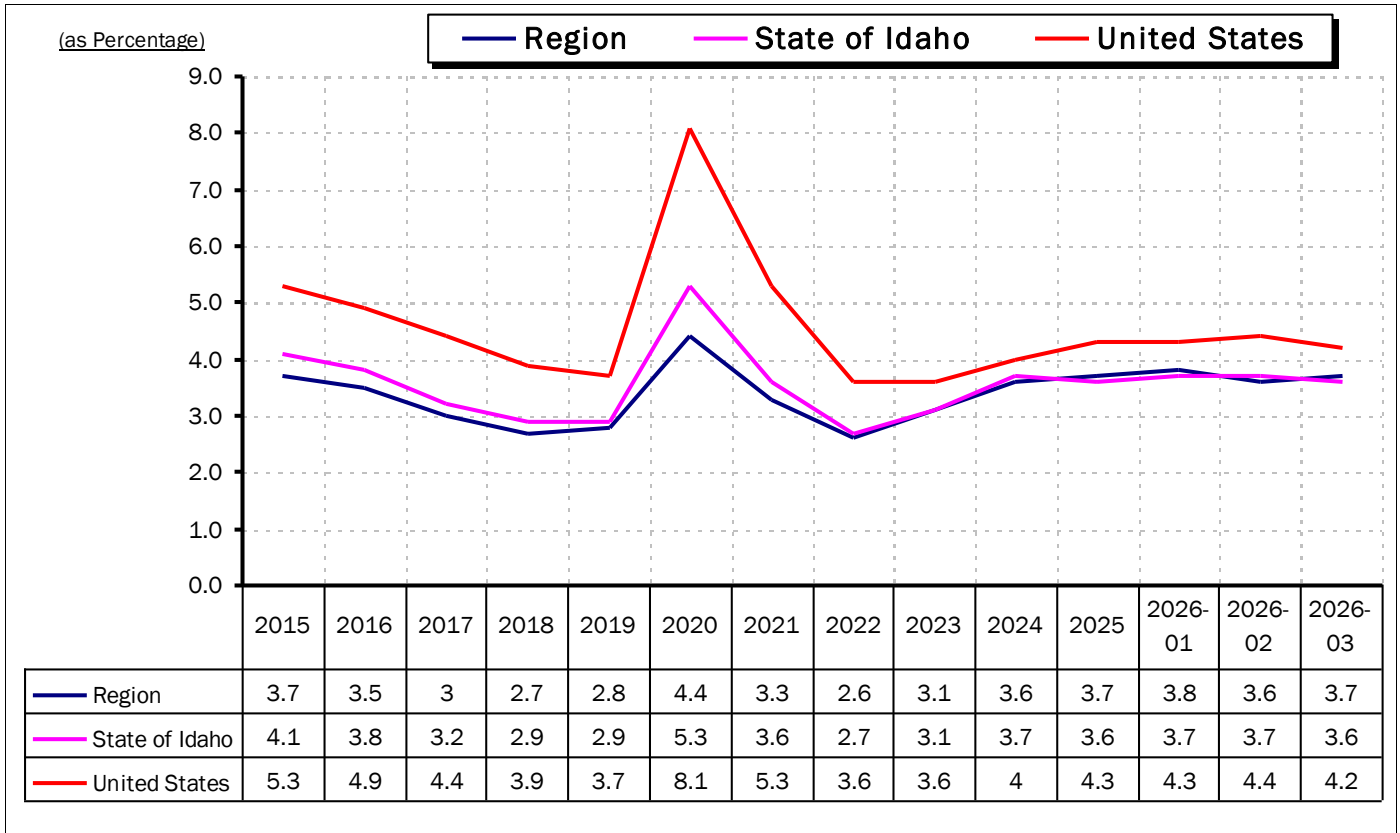

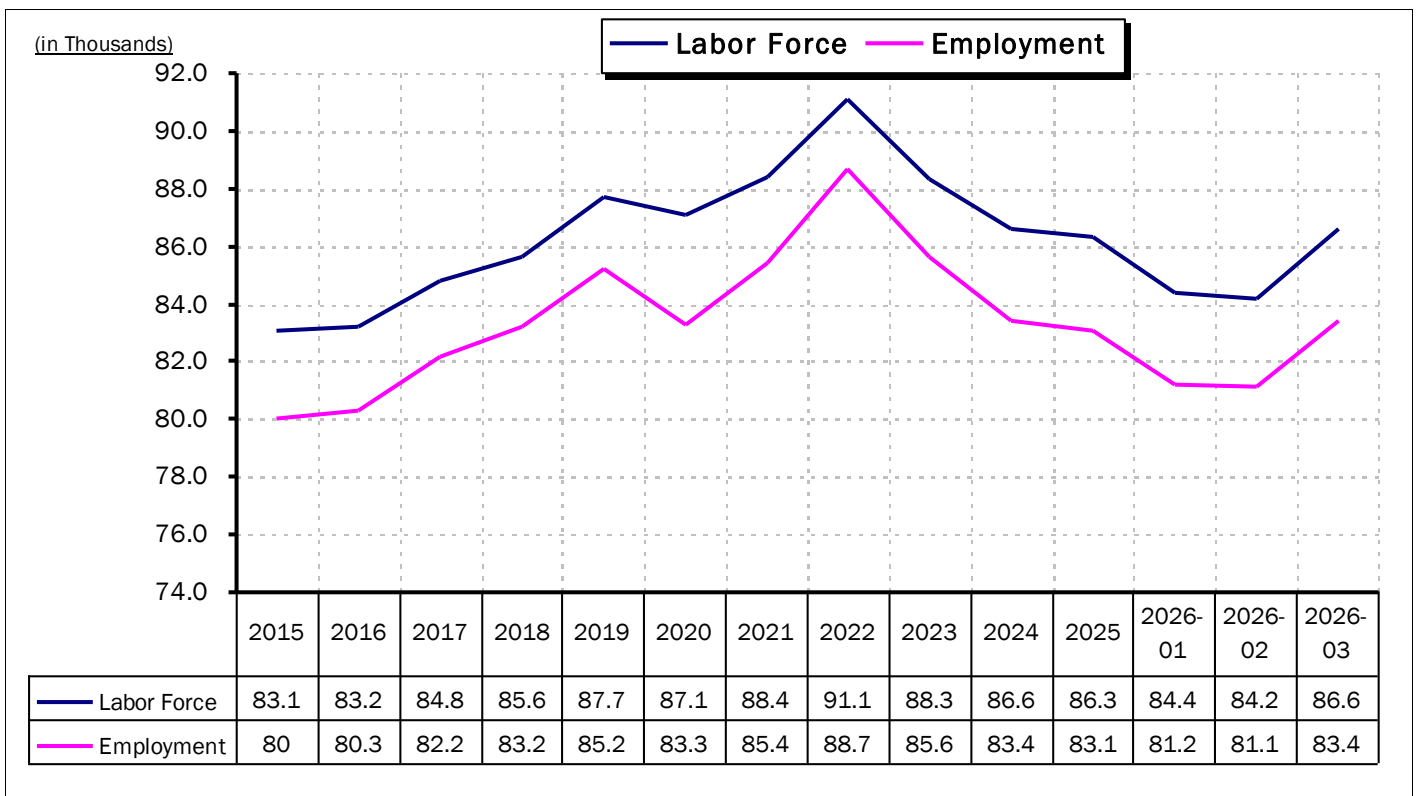

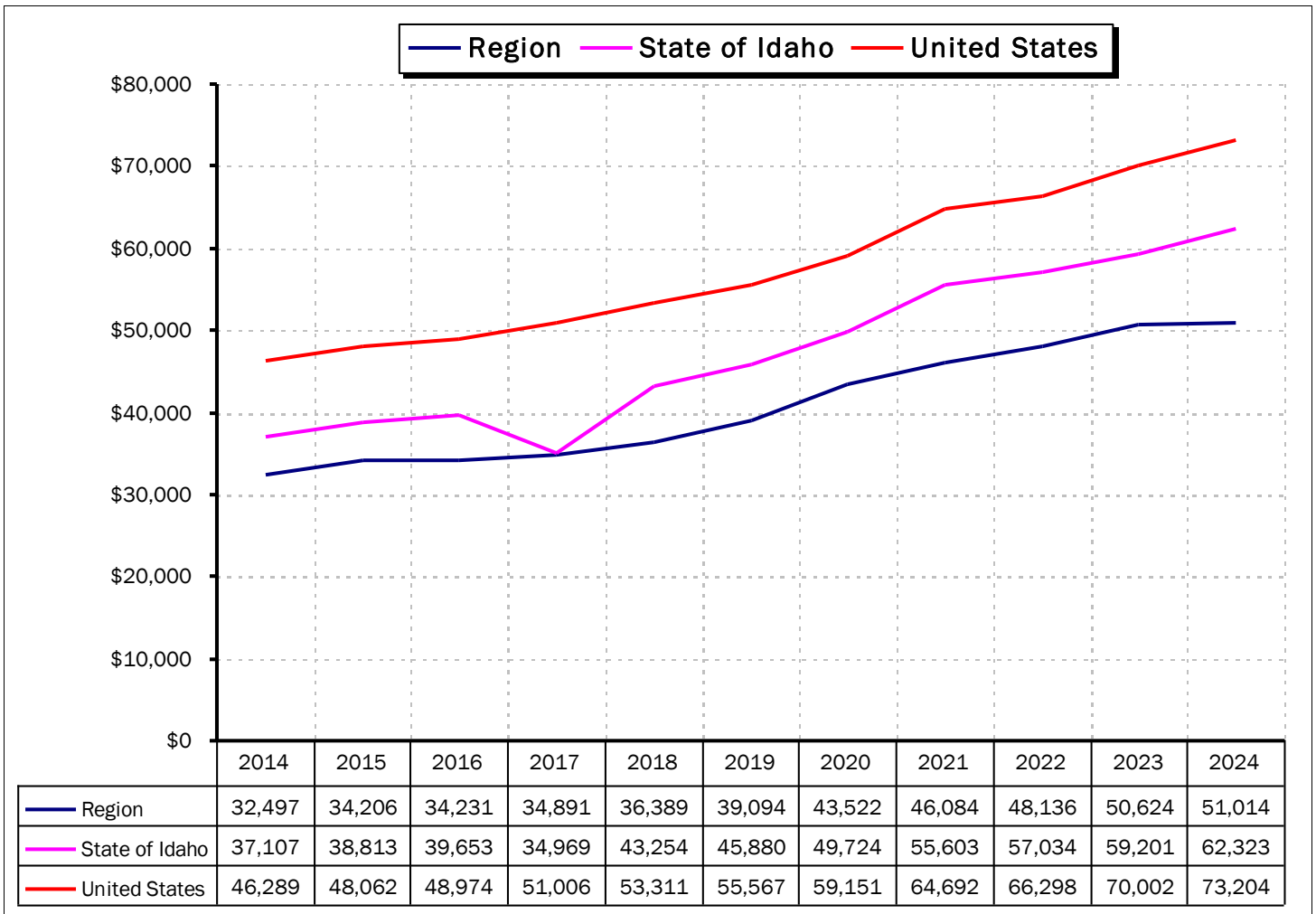

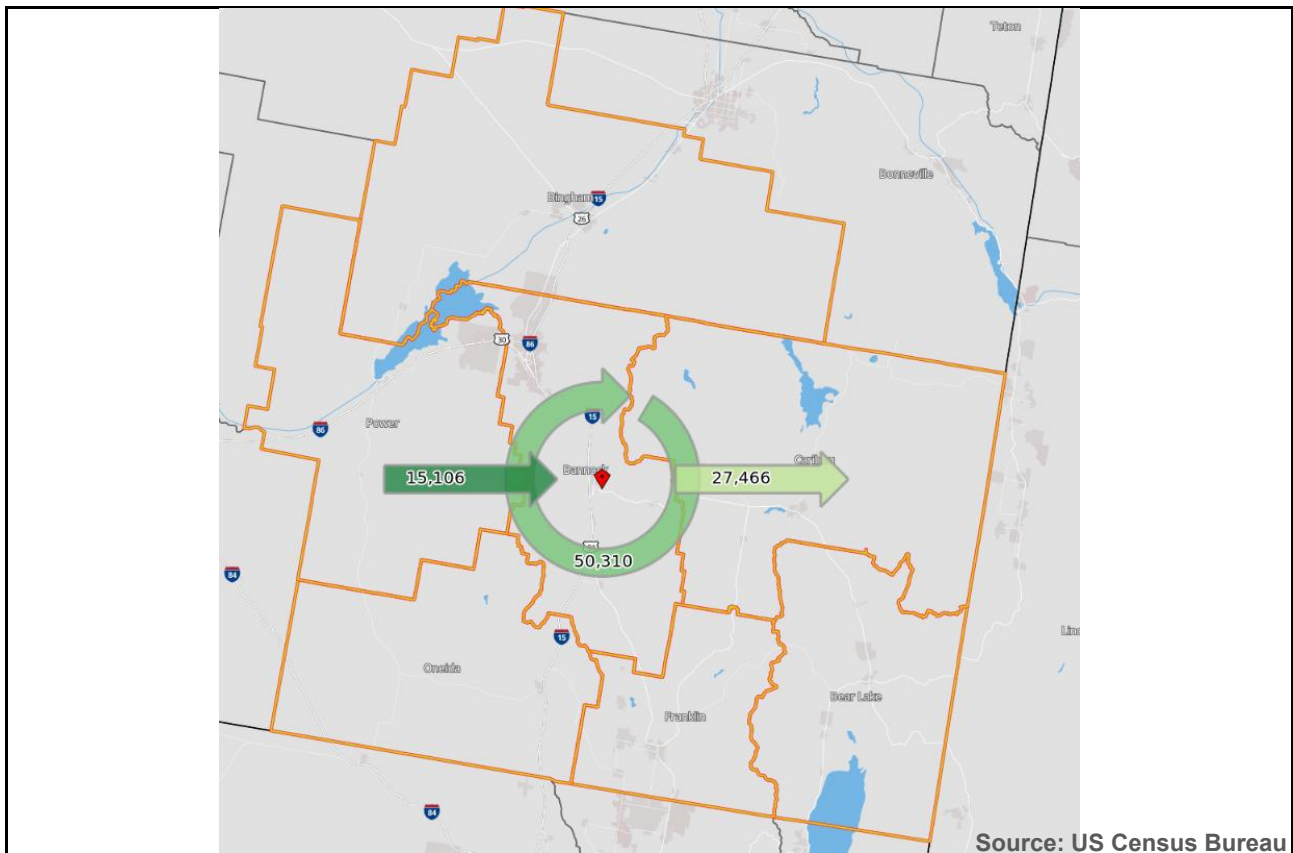

It is estimated that 50,310 workers lived and worked in Southeast Idaho in . Another 15,106 workers were employed in Southeast Idaho but lived outside, while 27,466 workers lived in the area but commuted outside for work.
