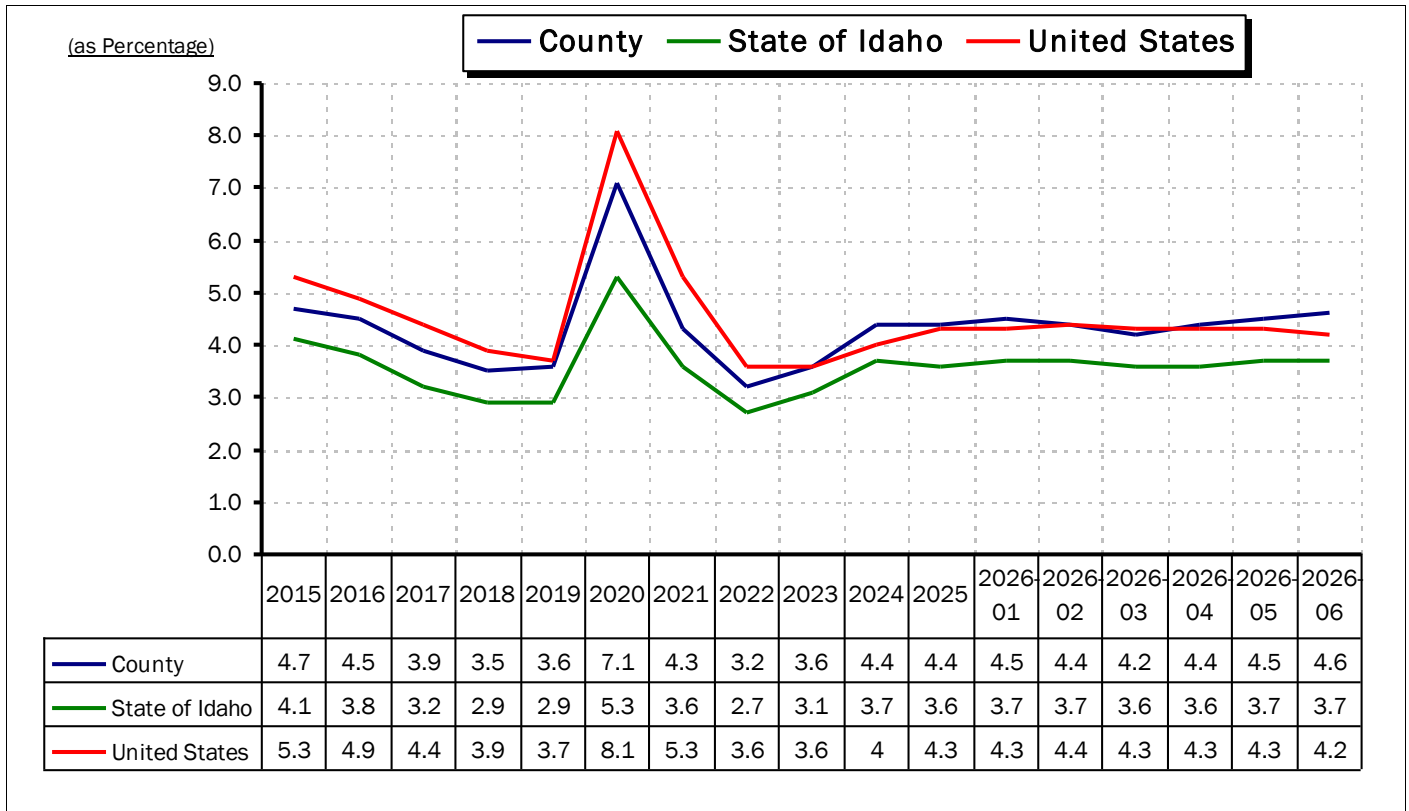

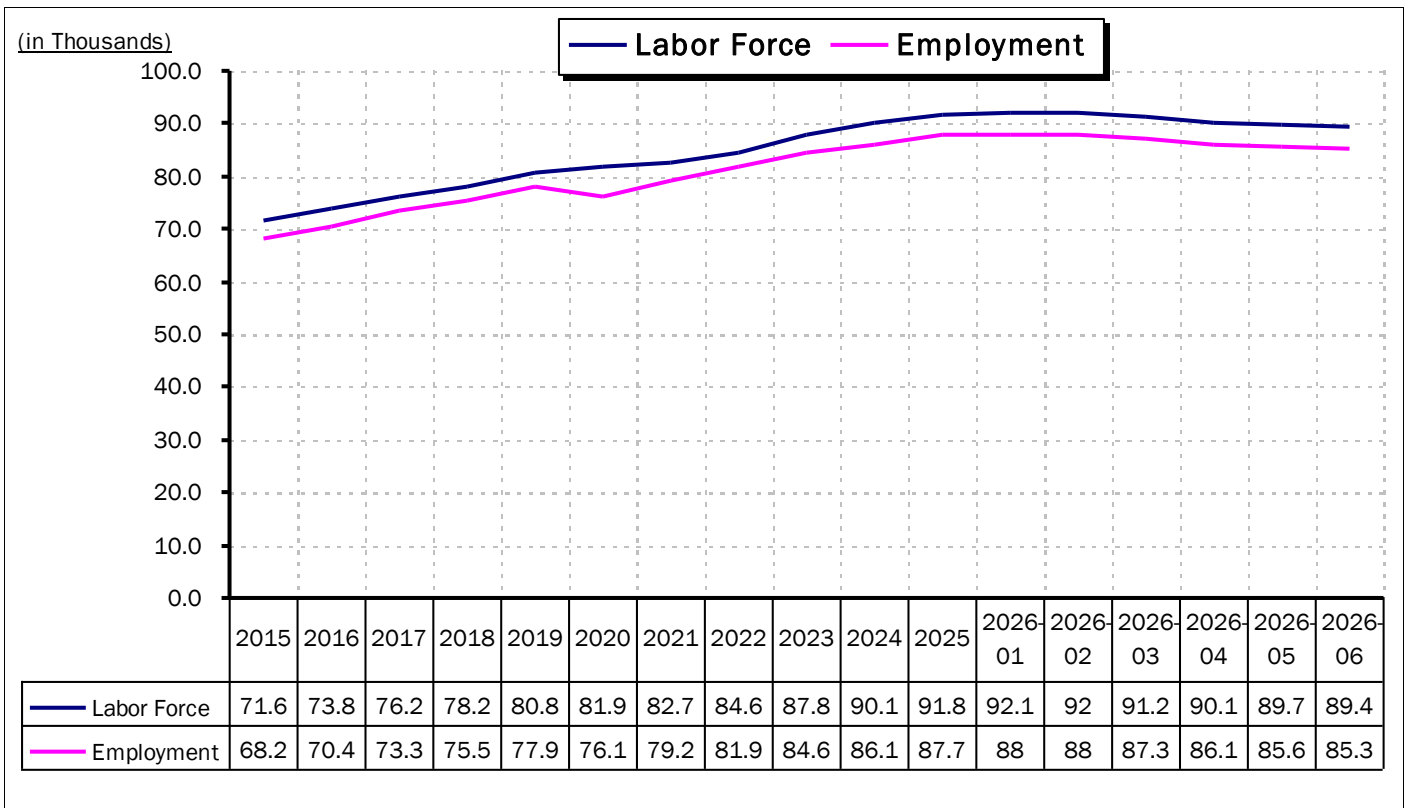

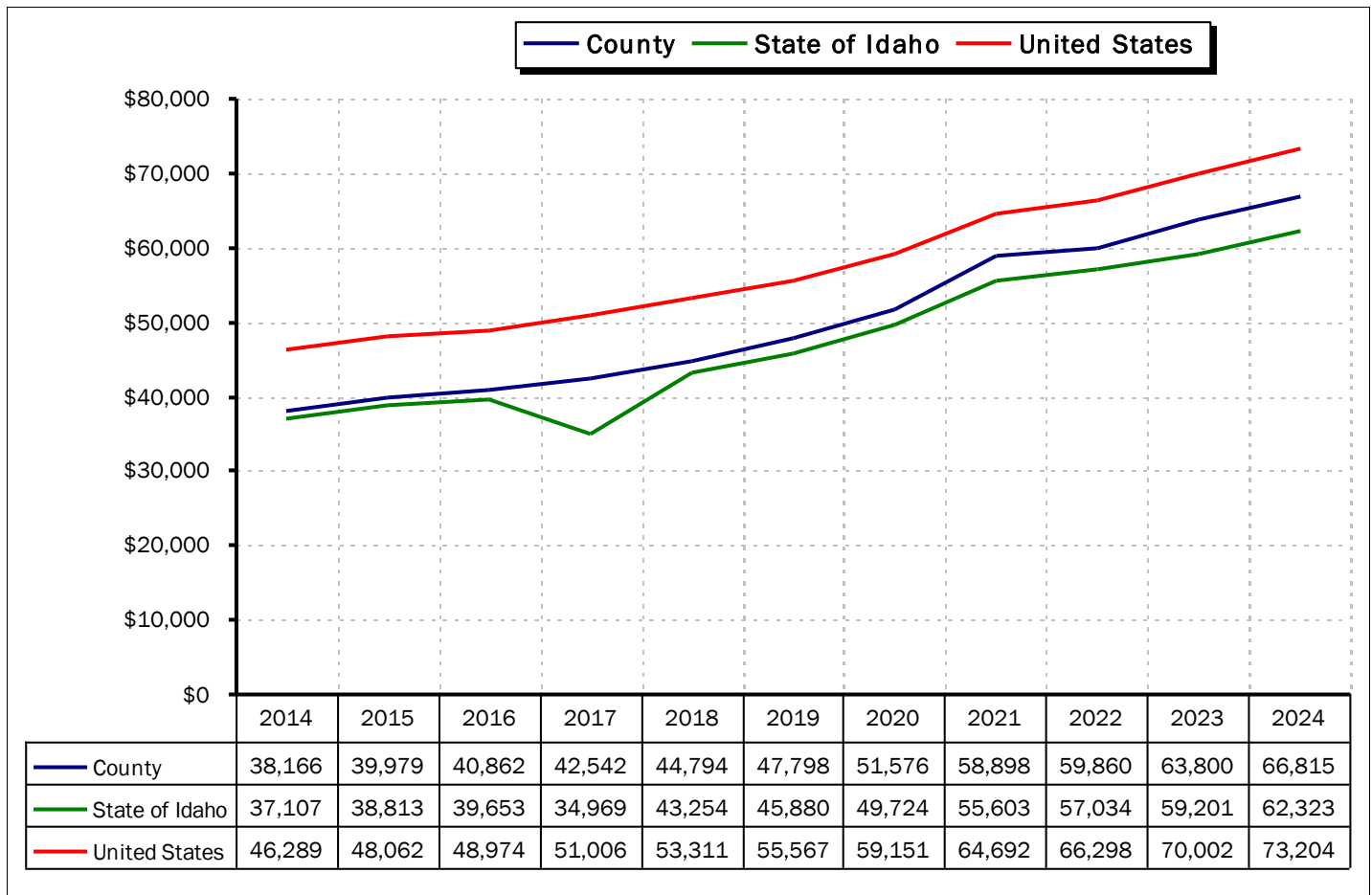

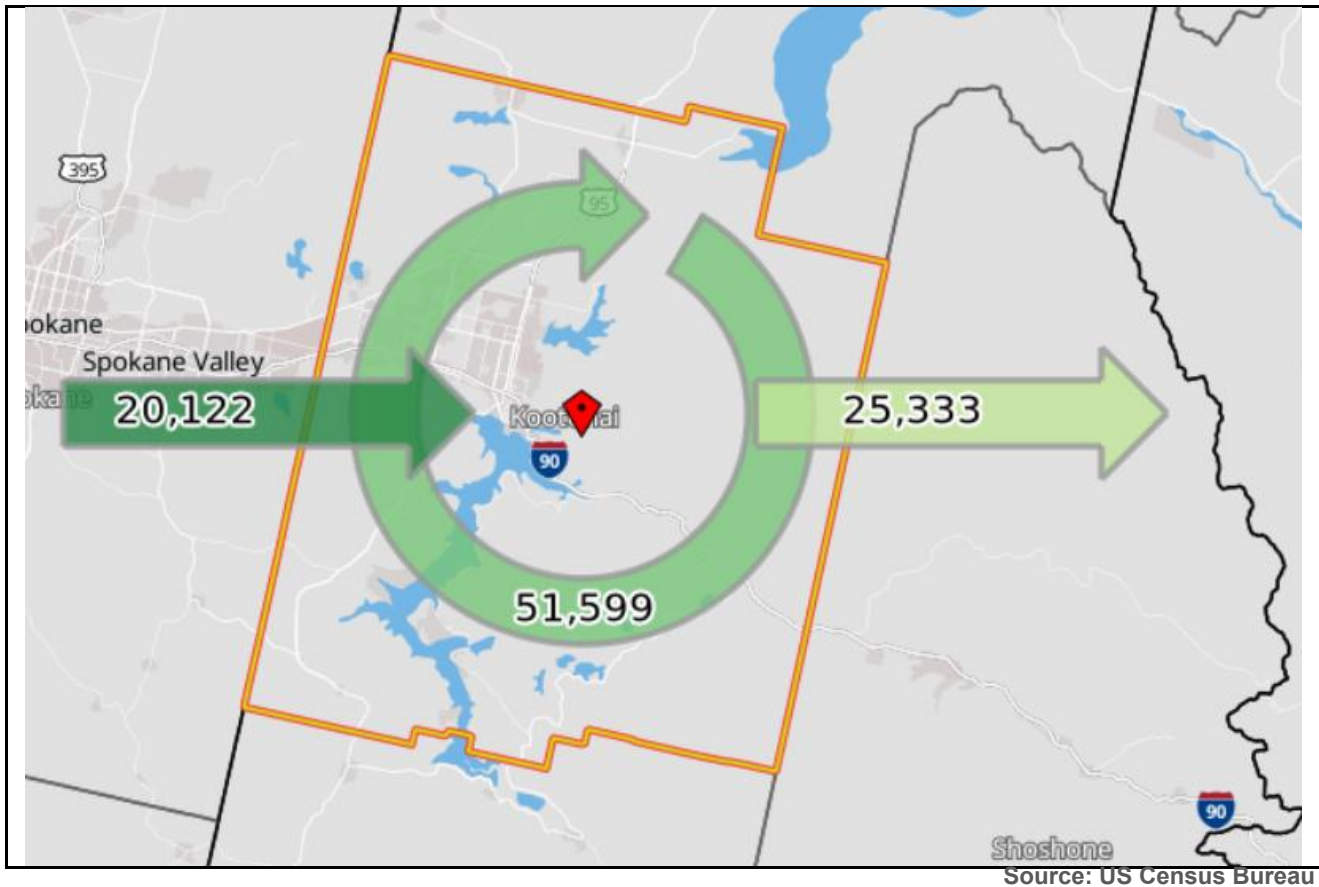
7. Per Capita Income, 2014 to 2024

It is estimated that 51,599 workers lived and worked in Kootenai County in 2023. Another 20,122 workers were employed in Kootenai County but lived outside, while 25,333 workers commuted to other counties for work.
