

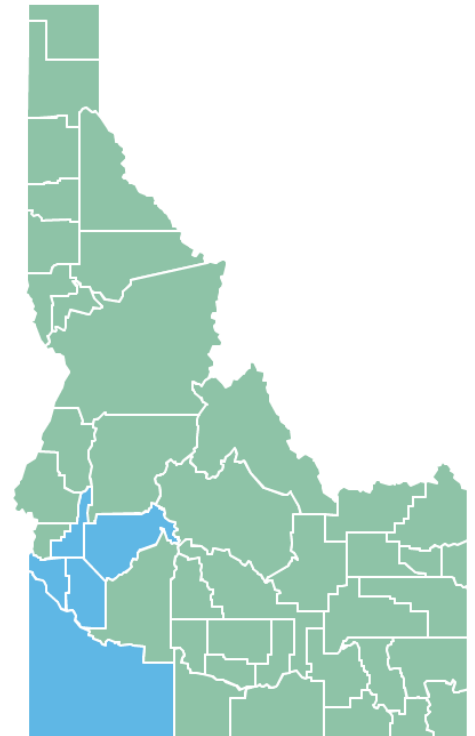

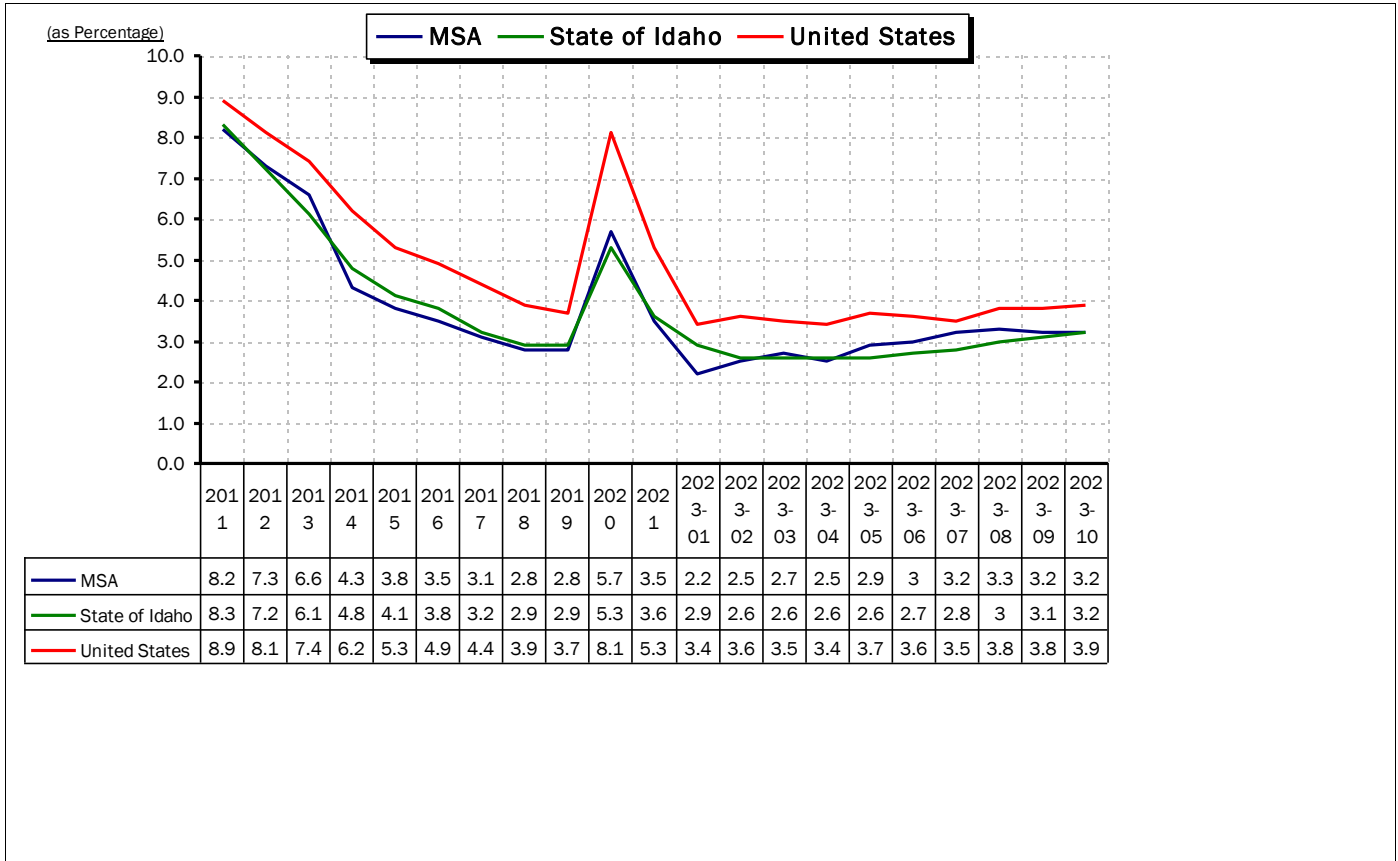

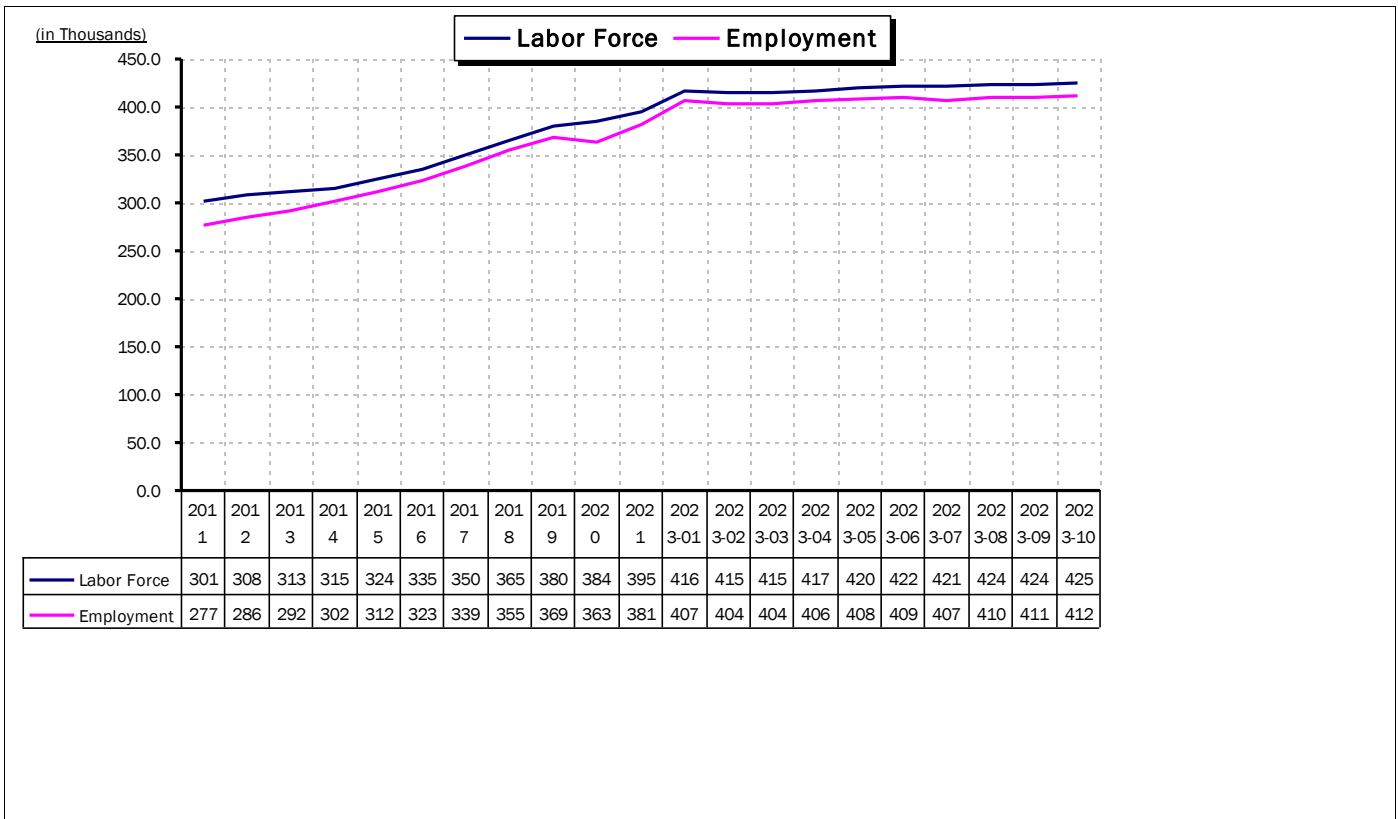

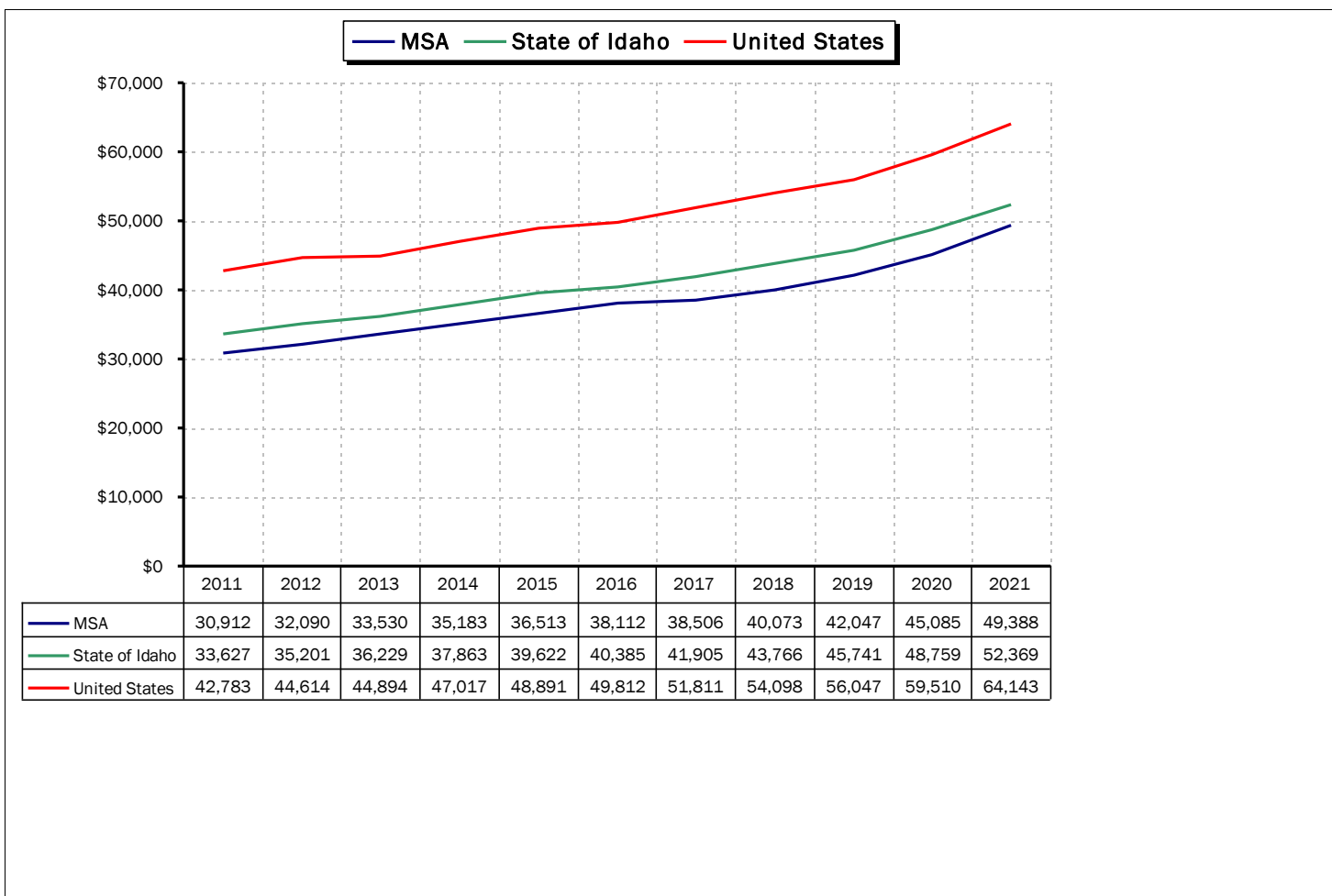

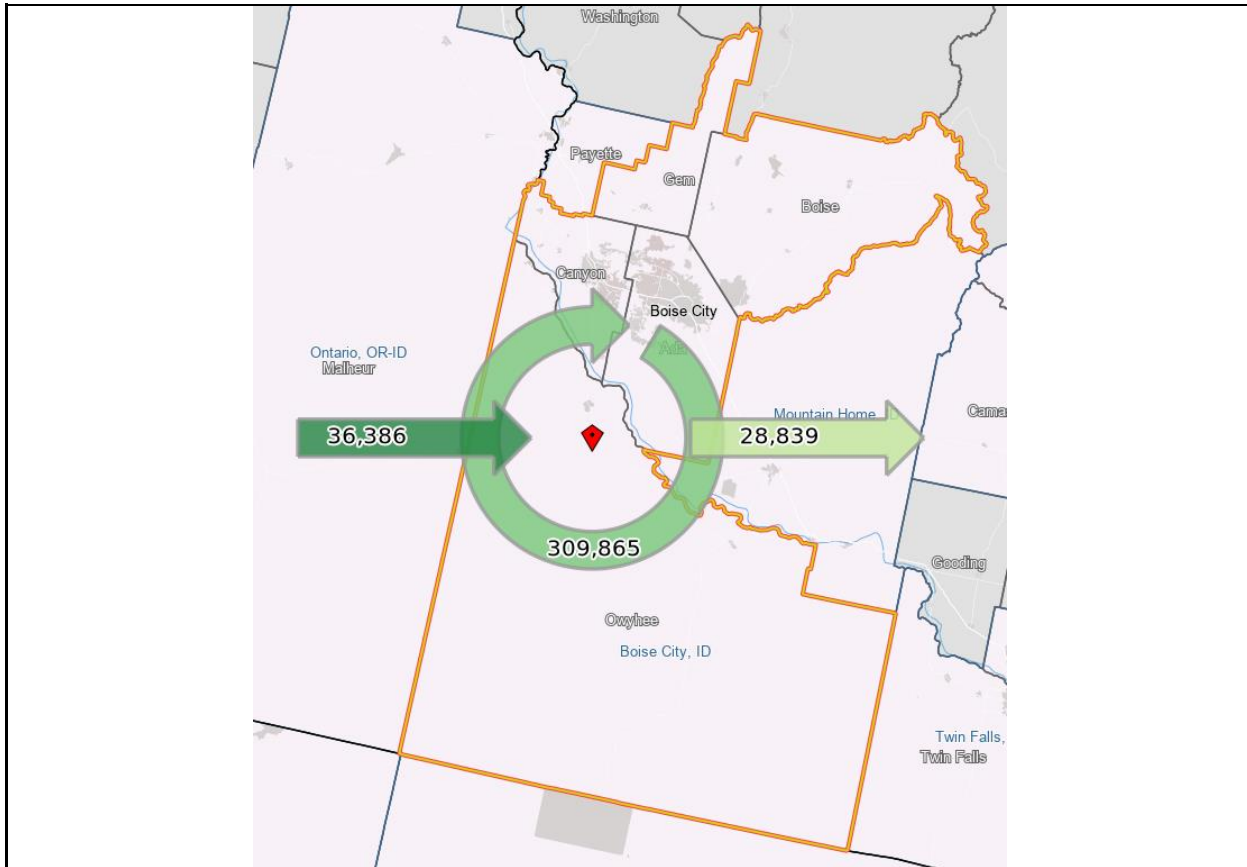
7. Real Per Capita Income, 2011 to 2021

It is estimated that 309,865 workers lived and worked in the Boise-Nampa MSA in 2020. Another 36,386 workers were employed in the Boise-Nampa MSA but lived outside, while 28,839 workers lived in the area but commuted outside for work.
