

Comparison of Seasonally Adjusted Unemployment Rate



Idaho and National Labor Force Compared





In June 2023, Idaho's Total Nonfarm Added 1200 Jobs, Growing by 0.1%




Over-the-month Change in Nonfarm Payroll Jobs by Industry, June 2023



Idaho Nonfarm Jobs (CES): Statewide Seasonally Adjusted Change by MSA




Over-the-month Change in Total Nonfarm Payroll, June 2023

Over-the-year Change in Total Nonfarm Payroll, June 2023





Idaho Unemployment Rate: Counties






Counties

- Thirty-two counties experienced unemployment rates above the 2.7% state rate for June.
- Twelve counties were at or below the 2.7% state rate.
- 3 counties with unemployment above 5% were:
 - Adams 5.8%
 - Clearwater 5.5%
 - Benewah 5.4%
- Madison county experienced the lowest unemployment rate at 2%.

Idaho Unemployment Rate: MSAs






MSAs

- Five MSA experienced an unemployment rate above June's state rate of 2.7%
 - Coeur d'Alene 3.6%
 - Twin Falls 3.1%
 - Boise 3%
 - Pocatello 2.9%
 - Lewiston 2.8%
- Idaho Falls continued to experience the lowest unemployment rate at 2.6%

Idaho Unemployment Rate: Micro and Labor Market Areas






Micro and Labor Market Areas

- Six of Idaho's smaller labor market areas experienced an unemployment rate greater than the state's 2.7% in June:
 - Sandpoint 4.2%
 - Idaho-Lewis LMA 4%
 - Mountain Home 3.3%
 - Blackfoot 3.1%
 - Hailey 2.8%
 - Moscow 2.8%
- Rexburg MicSA had the lowest rate at 2.2% in June 2023.

Idaho Unemployment Rate: Cities





Cities

- Eight cities were above the state's unemployment rate of 2.7%:
 - Coeur d'Alene 3.7%
 - Nampa 3.5%
 - Post Falls 3.3%
 - Caldwell 3.4%
 - Twin Falls 3.1%
 - Pocatello 3%
 - Eagle 2.8%
 - Idaho Falls 2.8%
- Rexburg had the lowest unemployment rate at 2% in June.
